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Program

Divine Intervention Project “Housing Opportunities for persons with HIV/AIDS” caters especially to dually diagnosed individuals who are positive for HIV/AIDS. Divine Intervention Project clients have to cope with being positive for HIV/AIDS, homelessness, and chemical dependency. This program ensures that the clients needs are holistically addressed by providing 28-day transitional housing and transportation, and promoting a healthy and safe life-style by providing nutritional services, access to medical care, case management, and substance abuse services.

About LHRC

Louisiana Health and Rehab Center, Inc. is a private non-profit provider agency founded June 13, 2000 to provide residential services to female recovering addicts and their dependent children. Since that time, the agency has grown in size and scope and presently, we successfully operate a variety of programs, both residential and community based. We continue to offer secure, therapeutic living environments for women recovering from addiction and their children. We also offer Supervised Independent Living, Personal Care Attendant, and Children’s Choice services to people who are developmentally disabled. We provide five to seven days detoxification services to adults, Supportive Education for children with Addicted Parents and Outpatient Substance Abuse Treatment to children and adults. We also provide Teen Pregnancy Prevention Services for adolescents, as well as Planned Therapeutic Recreation for children with severe mental illness. Finally, we provide Emergency Shelter services for abused and/neglected boys between the ages of eight to seventeen. Many of our program participants have become self-sufficient and are fully contributing taxpaying members of our society.
