(LHRC) is a private non-profit provider agency founded June 13, 2000 to provide residential services to female recovering addicts and their dependent children. Since that time, the agency has grown in size and scope and presently successfully operates a variety of programs, both residential and community based. We continue to offer secure, wholesome, therapeutic living environments for women recovering from addiction and their children.

Additionally, we provide Supervised Independent Living, Personal Care Attendant and Children's Choice services to people who are developmentally disabled. We provide detoxification services to adults and Outpatient Substance Abuse counseling to children and adults. We also offer Teen Pregnancy Prevention Services for adolescents, as well as Planned Therapeutic Recreation for children with severe mental illness. Many of our program participants have become self-sufficient and are fully contributing taxpaying members of our society.

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Eligibility Requirements

- *Must be a male between the ages of 8 to 17*
- *Must be referred by Division of Social Services or Office of Community Services statewide*
- *Must have been abused and/or neglected*
- *Must demonstrate behaviors that are seriously detrimental to the growth and development and/or welfare of themselves or others*
- *School performance may be markedly below expectations*
- *Severely depressed and have extremely low self esteem*
- *Emotionally disturbed and lack social skills*

LHRC-Awakening Emergency Shelter is an emergency shelter for boys between the ages of 8 to 17 with a therapeutic program designed to be supportive toward the elimination of inappropriate and anti-social behaviors, while developing life-coping skills.

It is our philosophy that every individual has worth, as well as potential to achieve goals if given the opportunity. We believe that each individual can achieve more and reach a greater level of independence if challenged, encouraged and supported to the necessary extent. We know that challenge, support and encouragement leads to accomplishment.
