Eligibility Requirements

- Participants must be age 22 or older
- Participants of the New Opportunities Waiver Program (NOW)
- Participants of the Supports Waiver Program
- Participants of Office for Citizens with Developmental Disabilities (OCDD)
- Participants of Louisiana Rehabilitative Services (LRS)

All participants will be assessed to determine the appropriateness for services.



Overview

Baton Rouge Day Program is a program designed to assist people with disabilities to become and remain successfully and competitively employed in integrated workplace settings.

Day Program seeks to identify jobs that provide wages at or above the minimum wage, fringe benefits and career potential.

To organize a team of well trained professionals who are sensitive to the needs of and can facilitate programming for a variety of individuals who meet the admission criteria.

Our main goal is to provide pre-vocational and vocational training to individuals seeking employment and career opportunities.

Services Provided

- **Pre-Vocational services** which are designed to impart social skills into person so that they are prepared to work or socialize in the community.
- **Vocational services** will allow each person to work together as a team in the community.
- **Employment services** will allow each person to be supported by a coach or mentor while finding, training and working on a job in the community.
- **Career Advancement services** will allow each person to gain additional skills to maximize their ability to obtain better employment.
