Eligibility Requirements

- Must be 18 years or older
- Must be an African American and/or Veteran
- Must be Pregnant or has had a child in the last 12 months
- Must have primary diagnosis of chemical dependency
- Must be AFDC, food stamp, and project independency eligible
- Must agree and commit to the four month program
