



Eligibility Requirements

We provide services to:

- · Any person that has been determined
 developmentally disabled as defined by the
 Division of Mental Retardation and
 Developmental Disabilities.
- · Any person who has been institutionalized or would otherwise require ICF/MR level of care, unless eligible to participate in Medicaid Home and Community-Based Waiver service.

Services

Personal Care Attendant:

Designed to meet the needs of consumers whose disabilities render them unable to perform certain independent tasks.

Supervised Independent Living:

Designed to train developmentally disabled individuals in the skills need to live independently within the community.

Our consumers are offered a variety of customized services/training relating to their individual needs.

Elderly Waiver Services:

Personal Care Attendant services provided to the elderly.

Long Term Care:

Personal Care Attendant services provided to individuals who need nursing facility level of care.
